

Data Protection Principles - Children First Uganda

Children First Uganda is a small, not for profit Charity which seeks to raise funds and provide expert help to the Uganda NGO CALM Africa. It holds a limited amount of personal data of individuals who have given their permission for this data to be held. The data held is used solely for the purpose of circulating newsletters, updates on developments and activities and to raise awareness of fundraising campaigns.

Access to and Maintenance of Personal Details Database

- Personal details of Volunteers, Friends of CFU and other interested parties are stored on a secure online database
- Maintenance of and access to the database is restricted to official / authorised CFU trustees and members
- Individuals whose data is stored on the CFU database, will be requested to update their personal details and contact preferences on an annual basis via the annual newsletter
- Any individual who wishes to see the personal data that is held for them on the CFU database should submit a request to the CFU Patron, Tony Bateman. Details will be send to the individual within 28 days.
